



Chicago-area coronavirus patient in good condition, Hoffman Estates hospital staff reports

A Chicago-area woman is in good condition after being diagnosed with the coronavirus, Illinois health officials said Friday.

The woman is the second U.S. patient to be diagnosed with dangerous new virus from China, the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention said.

The woman, who is in her 60s, came in through O'Hare International Airport from China on Jan. 13 after spending about two weeks in the Wuhan area.

Officials said she arrived to Chicago without showing any signs of illness, but three or four days later she called her doctor to report feeling sick.

As a new coronavirus spreads globally, people in the U.S. are advised to keep clean hands and cool heads.

It's a virus scientists have never seen before. Health officials don't know exactly where it came from, but it has traveled more than 7,000 miles since it was discovered late last month in central China. New infections are confirmed every day despite an unprecedented quarantine. The death toll is rising, too.

- -The current risk of local transmission remains low.



State sees first two cases of new virus

Health officials confirmed California's first two cases of the new strain of coronavirus in Los Angeles and Orange counties Sunday, brought by travelers who came from the epicenter of the outbreak in Wuhan, China.

In both counties, the virus infecting the two individuals was the same strain as the one that has <u>spread to more than 2,700 people</u> in 14 countries and territories and caused 80 deaths since it was discovered late last month in central China. Three other cases have been diagnosed in the U.S., one each in Arizona, Washington state and Chicago.





Prohibition began in 1920, but its legacy still felt today

The U.S. alcohol ban a century ago draws parallels from pot to politics. Americans are consuming more alcohol per capita now than in the time leading up to Prohibition, when alcohol opponents successfully made the case that excessive drinking was ruining family life. More states are also moving to decriminalize marijuana, with legalization backers frequently citing Prohibition's failure. 
Free tuition is a smart move for California




